# SURVEY REPORT OF THE CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES AS ON 31ST DECEMBER, 1980

Directorate General of National Statistics

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### Introduction

During the year 1981, an attempt was made by the Directorate General of National Statistics, in cooperation with Diwan of Personnel Affairs and various Government Ministries and Organizations to obtain the following detailed information for all the employees in Public Sector as on 31st December 1980. For obtaining these information the 'Personal File' of each employee was consulted:

Information obtained from 'Personal File' of the Employee:

- Nationality
- 2. Sex
- Date of Birth
- 4. Grade and Scale
- 5. Occupation
- Educational level attained
- 7. Year of Appointment
- 8. Basic Pay and Allowances
- 9. Training Courses attended and Period of Training
- 10. Field of Previous Experience and Period of Experience

In all, 'Personal Files' of 34141 employees were made available and consulted for obtaining the above information. The data thus collected was scrutinized and coded in the Directorate General of National Statistics and analysed on computer. A list of tables in which the information thus collected has been analysed is given as Appendex I to this Report.

2. In connection with the publication of Statistical Year Book for the year 1980, the Diwan of Personnel Affairs had supplied to this Directorate the information regarding the number of civil service employees as on 31st December 1980 and this information was published in the Statistical Year Book of 1980. Table Ibelow shows the number of civil service employees as reported by the Diwan of Personnel Affairs and the number of civil servants whose personal files were made available for collection of detailed information. It may be seen that in some Ministries, files of all their employees were not made available; hence the difference in number. Thus, analysis of the data as given further in this report is based on only 34141 civil service employees.

### Nationality

3. Table 2 shows the classification of 34141 civil servants under nationalities. About 63.1% of the total employees are Omanis, 14.6% Egyptians, 11.9% Indians and the remaining under other nationalities.

### Grades and Scales

4. Amont Omanis 2 employees are in special grade, 269 in Group I, 7488 in Group II and 13637 in Group III. Break up of 164 Omani employees working in Central Bank under grades and scales is not available. Among non-Omanis 161 are in special grade, 299 in Group I, 9135 are in Group II and 2959 in Group III. Table 3 shows the classification of Omani and non-Omani civil servants by sex, grades and scales under various groups. Table 4 shows such classification under i) Asians, ii) Arabs, iii) Africans and iv) Europeons/Americans.

### Year of Appointment

5. Classification of 34141 employees by the year of their appointment with the Government is given in Table 5 below. It may be seen therefrom that out of the total of 21560 Omani civil servants about 73% had been recruited during the years 1975 to 1980. While out of 12581 non-Omani employees about 92% had joined the Government service during this period. Maximum increase in the number of civil servants both Omanis and Non-Omanis took place during the last year 1980.

### Education Level Attained

6. Out of 21560 Omani civil employees, the literacy status of 3122 (14.48%) employees is not available. Out of the remaining 18438 Omani employees 10989 or 59.6% are illiterate and only 7449 or 40.40% literate. Among 7449 Omani literate employees 45.07% has attained Primary (any level), 28.86% Preparatory (any level), and 15.52% Secondary level. The remaining 10.55% had obtained a Diploma or a Degree. Among non-Omanis 83.79% are literate and 16.21% illiterate. Among literate non-Omanis 28.45% had attended school and attained any level under Primary, Preparatory or Secondary. The remaining 71.56 had obtained Diploma or a Degree. The classification Omanis and non-Omanis by broad educational level attained is given in Tables 5 and a detailed breakup is given in Table 6.

### Occupation

7. Civil Service Employees have been classified under International Standard Classification of Occupation (ISCO) upto 3-digit level and Table 7 below shows the distribution of Omani and non-Omani employees under major occupation groups. Among Omanis, the majority (31.96%) are in the major occupational group No.5 relating to 'Service Workers', following by 27.34% in No.3 - Clerical and Related Workers' (which includes Farashes as well), 21.05% are in Nos. 7/8/9 - Production and Related Workers, Transport Equipment Operators and Labourers and 14.49% are No. 0/1 - Professional; Technical and Related Workers. Among non-Omanis 61.48% of the total non-Omani employees are 'Professional; Technical and Related Workers', 13.23% are 'Service Workers', 12.43% are 'Production and Related Workers, Transport Equipment Operators and Labourers' and 11.06 'Clerical and Related Workers.

- 8. Further detaled classification of Omani and non-Omani civil employees is given in Table 8. It may be seen from this table that out of the total of 34141 civil service employees about 17.4% are teachers; 10.1% clerical supervisors or Government Executive officials; 10.9% Protective Service workers (including watchmen), 12.8% miscellaneous service workers; 6.9% Drivers; 5.6% Farashes and mail distribution clerks; 5.4% Professional Nurses; 2.8% Production Supervisors and others relating to remaining occupational categories.
- 9. Among the total number of 21560 Omani civil service employees, about 17.0% are Protective Service workers (including watchmen); 13.8% miscellaneous service workers; 13.4% clerical supervisors or Government Executive officials; 9.0% Drivers; 8.4% Farashes and mail distribution clerks; 3.6% Production supervisors; 3.6% Teachers; 2.3% workers in Religion and remaining relate to the occupational categories.
- 10. Among non-Omani civil service employees which total upto 12581, about 41.8% are Teachers; 10.9% miscellaneous service workers; 6.4% are Professional Nurses, 4.3% are clerical supervisors or Government Executive officials; 3.3% are Drivers; 2.0% are Medical Doctors and another 2% Engineers and Architects. Remaining belong to other occupational categories.

### Age-groups

11. Classification of 34141 Omani and non-Omani civil service employees by age-groups and sex is shown in Table 9 below. Among Omanis, about 21.2% of the total Omani employees are less than 25 years old, about 72.3% are in the age-group 25-54 years and the remaining 6.6% are 55 years of age or more. Among non-Omanis only 5% of the total non-Omani employees are less than 25 years of age, 92.6% are in the age-group 25-54 years and the remaining 2.3% are 55 years of age or more.

Distribution of Omani and non-Omani civil service employees by age-groups, groups of grade and sex is given in Table 10.

### Basic Pay

- 12. Distribution of 34141 Omani and non-Omani civil service employees by basic pay groups per month and sex is shown in Table 11. Out of a total of 34141 employees about 36.3% are drawing a basic salary of R.O. 90 or less per month and about 42.1% are in the pay group R.O. 91-200, 19.6% are in the pay-group R.O. 201-400 and 2.1% are getting R.O. 401 or more.
- 13. Among Omanis, out of a total of 21560 civil service employees, about 47.3% are getting a basic salary of R.O. 90 or less, 40.0% between R.O. 91-200, 11.4% are in the pay group 201-400 and the remaining 1.3% are drawing more than R.O. 400.
- 14. Among non-Omanis only 17.4 are drawing a basic salary upto R.O. 90, about 45.8% are in pay-group R.O. 91-200, 33.5% are between R.O. 201-400 and 3.3% are getting more than R.O. 400 per month.

### Total Salary

- In addition to the basic pay, civil service employees are eligible for certain allowances per month which include, housing or accommodation allowance, Electricity and Water allowance and fixed overtime allowance (to certain category of employee). Civil service employees in specified higher grades also get transport allowance and telephone allowance if these services are not provided by the Government. employees, as a rule get residential accommodation allowance and generally no housing facilities are provided by the Government. Non-Omani employees are provided with furnished/ semi-furnished residential accommodation according to the terms of their contract. Those non-Omani employees who are not provided with such facility by the Government get, instead of that; accommodation allowance. Information has also been obtained about the allowances received by each employee per month and in Table 12 below, all civil service employees are classified under total pay groups per month (basic pay plus allowances as received by them every month).
- 16. Out of a total of 34141 civil service employees, slightly less than 1/3rd (32.8%) are drawing a total salry per month upto R.O. 120 only. Another 42.2% are in group R.O. 121-250, 19.7% are getting between R.O.251-500 and 5.4% are getting more than R.O. 500/-.
- 17. Among Omanis about 41.4% are getting a total monthly salary upto R.O. 120 only. Another 42.3% are getting between R.O. 121-250, 10.7% between R.O. 251-500 and 5.4% more than R.O. 500 per month.
- 18. Among non-Omanis only 17.4% are getting a total salary upto R.O. 120 per month, 41.9% between R.O. 121-250, 35.2% in the group R.O. 251-500 and 5.5% are getting more than R.O. 500 per month as total salary.

### Field and Period of Training :

20. Information has been obtained as to whether the civil service employer had any regular training and if so in which subject or field and for what period of time. Table 14 below shows the classification of Omani and non-Omani employees by subject in which they had training. Out of a total of 34141 employees as many as 28617 has had no regular training in any subject. 517 employees had training in 2 subjects and 61 employees in 3 subjects. Distribution of 6163 employees (2891 Omanis and 3272 non-Omanis) by subject of training is shown below:

<sup>21.</sup> Among Omani employees, which had training, 30.1% are trained in 'Public & Business Administration', 18.0% in 'Languages', 14.8% in 'Education & Teacher Training' 7.9% in 'Medical Sciences', 6.5% in 'Communication', 4.8% 'Mass Communication & Documentation', 4.3% 'Engineering' and the remaining had training in other subjects.

22. Among non-Omanis, majority i.e. 38.5% are trained in 'Medical Services', 25.5% in 'Education & Teacher Training', 9.7% in 'Public & Business Administration', 4.5% in 'Engineering', 4.3% in 'Statistics and Mathematics', 3.4% each in 'Communication and 'Languages' and the remaining had training in other subjects.

### Period of Training :

23. Out of 6163 civil service employees who had any regular training, the information relating to the period of their training is not available for the number as high as 2153 (or 34.9% of the total). The classification of remaining 4010 employees who had training is shown by period of training in Table 15. Further classification by period of training and subject of training is given in Table 17.

### Field of Previous Experience

24. Information was collected regarding the type of experience the civil service employee had, if any, at the time of joining his/her present appointment. It was observed that out of a total of 34141 employees as many as 21736 employees (or 63.7%) has had no previous experience (or if they had any, it was not mentioned in their Personal Files). Some of the employees had experience in more than one field or subject. Table 17 shows the classification of those civil servants who had experience in any field.

25. Out of total of 3801 Omani employees who reported of having previous experience 31.1% had experience in 'Public & Business Administration', 26.0% in 'Miscellaneous Service', 9.0% in 'Crafts & Industries', 7.3% in 'Communication', 6.9% in 'Education & Teaching, 4.5% in 'Medical Services', 3.8% in Engineering and remaining in other subjects.

26. Among non-Omanis, 55.0% had previous experience in 'Education and Training', 15.4% in 'Medical Services', 10.8% in 'Public and Business Administration', 5% in Engineering and the remaining in other fields.
